**MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC FORUM
OF
THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

DALEVILLE COMMUNITY SCHOOL**

HELD: OCTOBER 28, 2012

A Public Forum of the Board of Trustees of Daleville Community Schools was held on Monday, October 28, 2013, in the Daleville Jr/Sr High School's Classroom 110. This meeting was held as an open forum for the public to ask questions and to share their vision of how they would like the School Board to lead the schools in the future.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm with the following Board Members present: Diane Evans, Vickie Rees, Joseph Kaelin, Kip Corn and Bobby Watters. Also present representing the schools were Superintendent Paul Garrison, Daleville Elementary School Principal Kim Beard, Daleville Jr/Sr High School Principal Rae Floyd, Daleville Jr/Sr High School Guidance Counselor Doug Hadley and Daleville Community School Director of Technology and Curriculum David Stashevsky. The School Board President, Diane Evans opened the meeting with a welcome to patrons and a pledge of allegiance to the flag.

The School Board President, Diane Evans opened the floor for comments and questions from the patrons.

The following are a few of the topics discussed at the meeting:

- Diane Evans thanked Mr. Stashevsky for setting up the Daleville Community Schools Face Book Page. Mr. Stashevsky said the page is a very positive way to get information to the public.
- Rae Floyd commented that the Daleville Jr/Sr High School website is updated regularly. Please take a look!
- Mr. Garrison presented a graph of ISTEP scores to the School Board and patrons.
- Kim Beard and Rae Floyd commented on how success time is used in each of their buildings.

- Rae Floyd presented a report on Athletics from Assistant Principal Eric Douglas.
- Doug Hadley presented a report on a few things the Counseling Department has been working on:
 1. The majority of the Seniors have already applied to at least one college.
 2. Mr. Hadley is working with Seniors, seeing what their personality and course interest may be to help them decide what they would like to do after graduation.
 3. Mr. Hadley is also working with outside agencies to encourage students to graduate and to point them in the right direction.
 4. Mr. Hadley has been attending several conferences finding even more ways to help the students.
- Rae Floyd and Kim Beard commented on the convocations each building has had concerning Anti-Bullying. They both commented that this is just the beginning of the Anti-Bullying curriculum.
- Mr. Garrison commented on how proud he is of the students of Daleville Community Schools. He stated that “our students represent Daleville well”. He stated that there is a noticeable change in the respect that the students show to staff and other students each day.
- The School Board commented on how thankful they are for the relationship we have with the Daleville Police Department. The police presence in and around the buildings each day is much appreciated.

With no further discussion brought before the board the meeting was adjourned at 6:44 p.m.
